

Pop-Up Event Road Crew On-call

Position Announcement: January, 2022

Hiring: Continuous **Position:** On-call status

Position Summary:

With its children's museum space closed for the duration of the pandemic, Habitot Children's Museum's play and learning exhibits, mobile art studio, and interactive programs are now being presented in community locations, private homes, corporate headquarters, and school sites. Twenty to thirty events are planned for 2022.

Habitot is seeking multiple team members to join its Pop-Up Event Road Crew. For each event, two to three crew members will be scheduled to load and unload all exhibits, furniture, and equipment, and set-up, and break-down events. Events will take place in outdoor locations such as community parks in Alameda or Contra Costa County.

Most events will require a road crew on a Saturday or Sunday, between 7:00am and 9:30 am, and/or between 5:00pm and 7:00 pm. Road crew members will be paid hourly. Those who work most events will work approximately 14-20 hours per month. All road crew members must be fully vaccinated/boosted against COVID-19 and wear masks during work hours.

The position is supervised by the Road Crew Supervisor with support from the Reservations and Events Coordinator who will be present at all events.

Major Responsibilities:

- Under direction, carefully load and unload all exhibits, furniture, and equipment from a 16' truck
- Position all exhibits, furniture, and equipment under the direction of the Road Crew Supervisor and/or Events & Reservations Coordinator
- Set up and take down the fencing perimeter and pop-up tents at each event

• Strictly follow safety guidelines to maintain safe working conditions for all team members as well as the integrity of all exhibits, furniture, and equipment

Qualifications:

- Ability to lift and carry up to 50 lbs
- Availability for weekend shifts, early mornings and late afternoons/evenings
- Punctuality and reliability
- Follows directions; eager to learn systems
- Must have own transportation
- Fully vaccinated (including boosters) against COVID-19
- Preferred: experience with moving furniture, warehouse stocking, exhibit/trade show installations, inventory management, physical labor

Compensation: \$20-\$22 per hour depending upon experience. Paid bi-weekly.
